All scholarship applicants shall submit an application, which shall include a biographical record and supporting material, including essays, letters of recommendation, grade transcripts, and special awards. The Foundation will work with donors to develop the scholarship application form for each Scholarship Fund.

Scholarships must be awarded on a nondiscriminatory basis to grantees, and the objective procedures used in the process must be confirmed to gain IRS approval. B. Special Procedures If for any reason, a Scholarship Grant is paid to a person other than the educational institution attended by the scholarship recipient or if the Scholarship Grant is used for expenses other than qualified tuition and related expenses within the meaning of IRC § 117(b)(2) or for room and board, SCF must receive a report on the progress of each recipient of such a Scholarship Grant at least once each year.
